72	<b>Notes for Group A:</b> James Bland, The Immigrant, (b. 1661 in England; d. 1709 Stafford Co., VA) was the son of George Bland (b. 1636), the grandson of James Bland (b. ca 1600), and the great-grandson of James Bland (b. ca 1575) - all of Penrith, St. Andrews Parish, Cumberland Co., England. It is possible that the Most Recent Common Ancestor in <b>Group A</b> may go back further than The Immigrant, but for now it is assumed that James (b. 1661) was the source of the DNA for this line [the line of James Bland b. ca 1575 and his forebears] in the U.S., through one of his three known sons, <b>William</b> (b. 1686), <b>James</b> (b. 1687) or <b>John</b> (b. 1688). It would not be helpful, therefore, to show the oldest known ancestor of anyone in this group as James (b. ca 1575); that is assumed for all. I have, therefore, tried to show which of The Immigrant's sons was the ancestor (proved or theorized) of each participant.
